SUBJECT: Resident serving on the Board of Commissioners

The Department of Housing and Urban Development issued a Final Rule, 24 CFR-964 dated October 21, 1999 requiring Resident Membership on the Board of Commissioners. The LaFollette Housing Authority (LHA) hereby notifies all Public Housing and Housing Choice Voucher residents of a vacant position on the Board of Commissioners to be filled by a resident.

In order to be eligible for board membership, the resident's name must appear on the lease, must be at least 18 years of age, and cannot be an employee of the housing authority. The resident board member will be required to attend Board meetings held on the third Monday of each month at 6:00 p.m. at LHA's Central Office located at 802 South Fourth Street, LaFollette, Tennessee. Although transportation will be the resident's responsibility, mileage expenses will be reimbursed at the current IRS rate for travel to and from each meeting.

Residents interested in serving as a board member must contact LHA by phone or by mail by no later than close of business on Thursday, July 8, 2021.
